Use RTLS Data to Predict and Prevent Bottlenecks. Your RTLS platform isn't just a real-time tool—it's a goldmine of historical data. By reviewing location and movement trends, you can identify recurring choke points in patient flow, equipment availability, or staff response times.

Pro tip: Run a weekly report to spot peak congestion areas or repeated delays, then adjust workflows or resource allocation before they become chronic issues. This proactive approach can improve throughput without adding staff or infrastructure.
